PACKING LIST

Attire for the Summit is business casual

- Business casual wear for all Summit sessions; no jacket or tie necessary. Be prepared with slacks and/or skirts, button-down shirts, and sweaters.
- Casual clothing for travel to and from D.C., as well as for recreational time and evening activities
- Comfortable shoes for travel and walking to and from the NEA
- Warm outerwear, gloves, scarf, hat, and umbrella. (D.C. is cold and rainy in the winter.)
- Pajamas
- Personal toiletries and medications*
- Metro card (provided in YP4 mailing)
- All travel documents, including plane ticket, itinerary, and government-issued photo I.D. (necessary for air travel)
- Estimated expenses: YP4 will cover expenses throughout the weekend for transportation, food, lodging, and Friday's optional tour. This includes three meals a day and some snacks. Should you require additional food, snacks, or beverages, please be prepared to incur those costs personally. In addition, any souvenirs, sightseeing fees or personal items purchased during the weekend will be at your own cost.
- Come prepared with thoughtful questions for speakers during the breakfast and lunch plenary sessions.
- Please mentally prepare your goals for the 2008 Young People For Fellowship, as well as what you hope to gain from the experience.

* Remember that due to heightened security, you must travel only with liquids in containers no larger than 3 oz. All containers must fit into a Ziploc bag. (The hotel will provide shampoo, lotion and soap.)
